Ruakākā Beach Holiday Park sits on 13.8 hectares of Department of Conservation reserve land, surrounded by a tidal estuary and home to many bird species. The park has been part of the community since the 1930s.

The Department of Conservation created the Ruakākā Reserve Board to care for the land, and we work closely with campers and the local community to plan for the park's future.

We offer a range of accommodation options: basic cabins, water view cabins, powered and non-powered sites, and water view sites.


Tents, caravans, and campervans are welcome on all sites, so everyone can find a place to stay.


As a not-for-profit park, all camping fees are reinvested into improvements and future projects, guided by feedback from our campers.


We live by the Tiaki Promise — caring for our people, our place, and our culture.

## Seasonal Sites Summer 2025/26

We have seasonal sites available from 24 October 2024 to 1 May 2025!

- Includes up to 6 nominated people (extra guests welcome at the nightly rate)
- Caravan & awning allowed, with a wooden floor inside the awning area
- No fixed structures permitted
- Must be used at least 2 nights per fortnight and on statutory long weekends
- Must be occupied 80% of the time between Boxing Day and 1 Feb
- Friends can stay without you, but please email us in advance
- Power must be switched off at our camp outlets when unoccupied

- Camp 1 & Camp 5 \$2,800
- Camp 4 \$3,700
- Payment plan available 4 instalments: 1 Aug, 1 Nov, 1 Feb, 1 Apr
